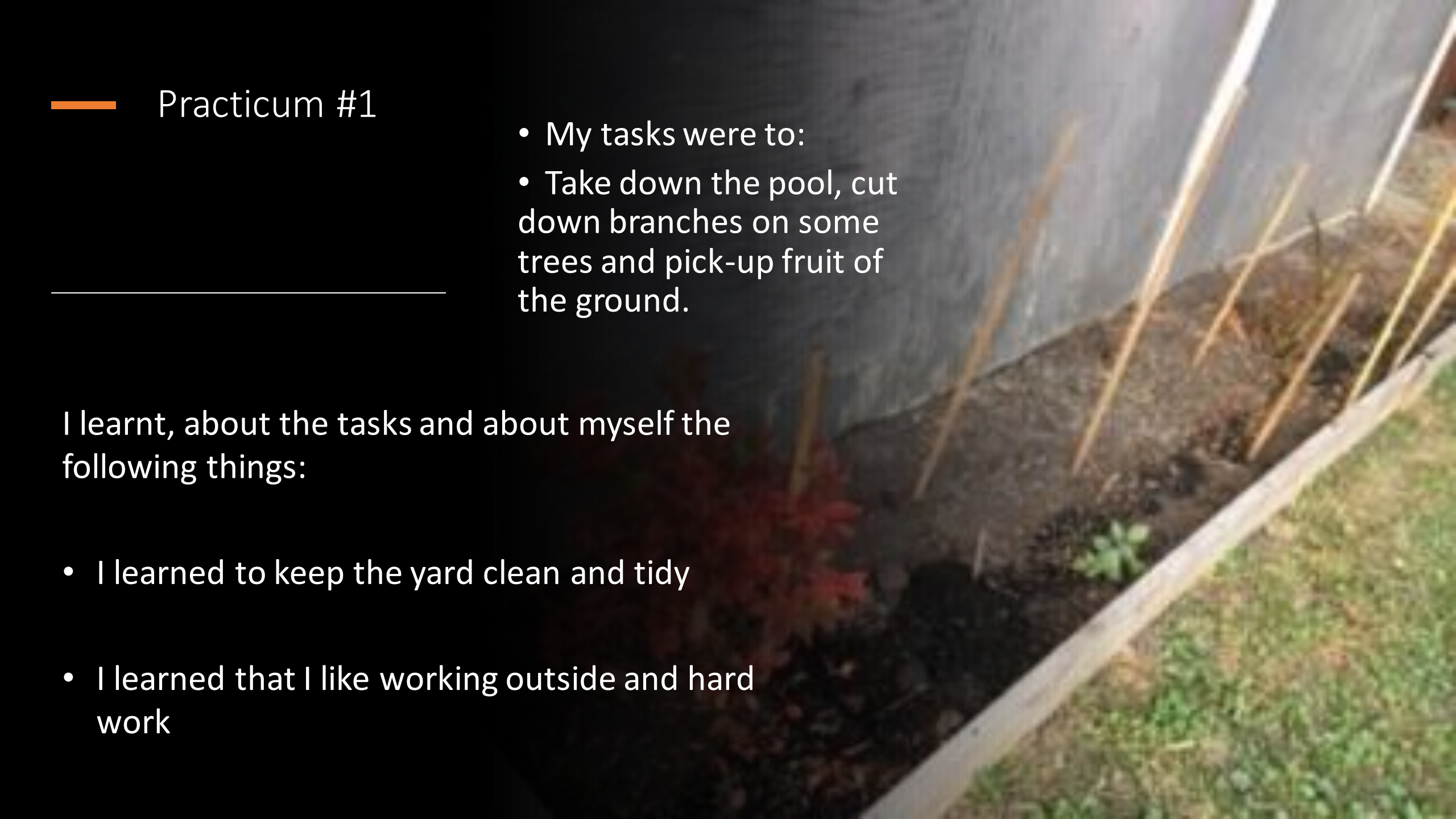

- I learned that I like working outside and hard work

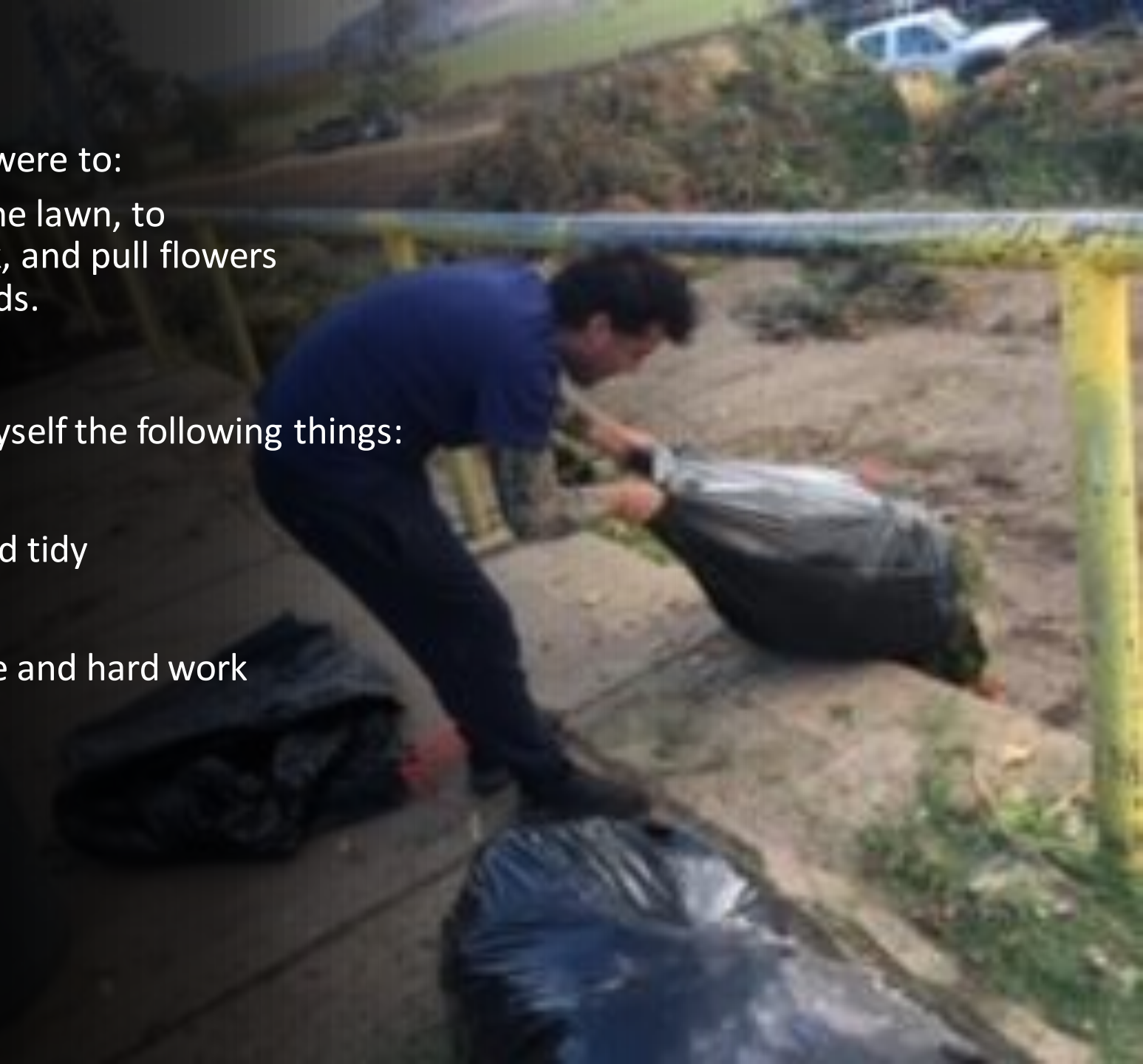


— Practicum #2
